THE COURT ORDERS THAT:

Leave to amend originating application

1. Pursuant to r 8.21 of the *Federal Court Rules 2011* (Cth) (FCR), the plaintiffs have leave to amend the originating process filed 16 April 2026 in the form of exhibit “RJH-122” to the Affidavit of Richard John Hughes affirmed 29 April 2026.

Service of court documents

2. Pursuant to r 10.24 of the FCR:

(a) personal service of:

- (i) the amended originating process referred to in order 1, above;
- (ii) the redacted affidavit of Richard John Hughes filed 16 April 2026 accompanying the originating process; and
- (iii) the redacted affidavit of Richard John Hughes filed 29 April 2026,

(together, the “Documents”),

on the creditors of the defendants is dispensed with;



- (b) instead of being personally served, notice of the Documents shall be given to creditors:
 - (i) by the plaintiffs placing a scanned copy of the Documents together with a copy of this order on the Halo website maintained by the plaintiffs at <https://aurestructuring.deloitte-halo.com/service/website/Redflow> (Website);
 - (ii) by the plaintiffs publishing a circular on the Website containing a link to the Documents on the Website; and
 - (iii) by sending an email to the email address for each creditor whose email address has been imported into the Halo platform, attaching the circular containing the link to the Documents on the Website.
- 3. Pursuant to s 90-15(1) of the *Insolvency Practice Schedule (Corporations)*, written notice required to be given under s 579J(1) of the *Corporations Act 2001* (Cth) will be validly given to the eligible unsecured creditors of the defendants if given in the following manner:
 - (a) by placing a scanned copy of the Documents together with a copy of this order on the Website;
 - (b) by the plaintiffs publishing a circular on the Website containing a link to the Documents on the Website; and
 - (c) by sending an email to the email address for each creditor whose email address has been imported into the Halo platform, or who is a registered user of the Halo platform, attaching the circular containing the link to the Documents on the Website.
- 4. Pursuant to r 10.24 of the FCR:
 - (a) personal service of the Documents on the shareholders of the first defendant is dispensed with;
 - (b) instead of being personally served, notice of the Documents shall be given to shareholders of the first defendant:
 - (i) by the plaintiffs placing a scanned copy of the Documents together with a copy of this order on the Website;
 - (ii) where the plaintiffs have an email address for a shareholder of the first defendant, by sending an email to each such shareholder attaching a circular containing a link to the Documents on the Website; and
 - (iii) where the plaintiffs do not have an email address for a shareholder of the first defendant but have a postal address for that shareholder, by sending



by post to each such shareholder a circular containing a link to Documents on the Website.

Timetable

5. On or before 22 May 2026, any person (each, an “Interested Person”) wishing to be heard in relation to the plaintiffs’ amended originating process is to file and serve:
 - (a) a notice of appearance in accordance with r 2.9(1) of the *Federal Court (Corporations) Rules 2000* (Cth); and
 - (b) an affidavit stating any facts on which the Interested Person intends to rely.
6. On or before 1 June 2026, the plaintiffs are to file and serve on each Interested Person:
 - (a) any further affidavits on which they intend to rely; and
 - (b) an outline of submissions (limited to 15 pages).
7. On or before 12 June 2026, each Interested Person is to file and serve an outline of submissions (limited to 15 pages).
8. The hearing of the amended originating process is to be listed at 9:30 am AEST on 18 June 2026.

Confidentiality

9. Pursuant to section 37AF(1) of the Federal Court of Australia Act 1976 (Cth), on the ground specified in s 37AG(1)(a) of the Federal Court of Australia Act 1976 (Cth), that the unredacted versions of:
 - (a) the affidavit of Richard John Hughes filed 16 April 2026; and
 - (b) the second affidavit of Richard John Hughes filed 16 April 2026; and
 - (c) the affidavit of Richard John Hughes filed 29 April 2026,be maintained on the Court’s electronic file as a confidential document and not made available for inspection by any person without leave of the Court.

10. Costs reserved.

THE COURT NOTES THAT:

- A. Any creditor of a defendant, or shareholder of the first defendant, may be provided with an unredacted version of the documents specified in order 5 upon provision by that person of a written undertaking to the plaintiffs to keep the redacted information confidential.
